Fred and Jenny Kosin were raised in Christian homes and in assembly fellowship. They met at

Emmaus Bible College and were married in 1961. After being commended to the Lord's work in 1966 they shared in the establishment of Hiawassa Bible Chapel in Orlando, Florida along with Svend and Rhoda Christensen. From there they went to South Carolina where they were exercised to strengthen the assembly in Florence. While there they also ministered at various camps, retreats and conferences across the US and Canada.

In the early 1980's Fred and Jenny began a ministry of encouraging missionaries at conferences that took them to Europe, Central Africa, South Africa, Singapore and other mission fields- a ministry lasting over 30 years. These travels also included giving practical help such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical and, of course, counselling to individual missionaries.
