Born 15 Nov. 1920 in Norland, Victoria county, Lindsay area, Ont. Predeceased by her parents, John Winterburn and Carrie Bell Pasmore of Norland,

brothers John Theodore "Jack" (1919-1999), Cecil Ralph (1922-2003) and sister Alma Stella May (1930-1990).

Pearl's maternal grandparents, James Barlow Pasmore and Edith May Courtemanche lived in North Bay and are buried in Terrace Lawn Cemetery.
