HUSBANDS AND WIVES:

7 features of Christ's relationship with His Church

Christ & His Church	Husbands & Wives
He is Head of the Church (vs. 23)	* Wives should submit to their husbands * Husbands should take active lead.
He is Saviour of the body (vs. 23)	Husbands should protect their wives
He loves the Church (vs.25)	Husbands should love their wives sacrificially
He gave Himself for her (vs. 25)	Husbands should put their wives ahead of themselves
He sanctifies the Church (vs. 26)	Husbands should help their wives to develop spiritually through God's Word.
He nourishes and cherishes her (vs. 29)	Husbands should provide for their wives
He is united to us, the members of His body (vs. 30)	Husbands and wives should be loyal to one another

Summary exhortation (vs. 23):

Husband, love your wife. Wife, respect your husband.

Four important principles in bringing up children:

- 1. Love
- 2. Discipline
- 3. Example
- 4. Provision

MASTERS AND BONDSERVANTS

Lessons we can draw from this passage and apply to employer/employee relations:

- * Respect your employer, boss and/or foreman (6:5)
- * Be sincere and honest (6:5)
- * Be marked by integrity (6:6)
- * Be a dedicated worker and be productive (6:5-8)
- *Note the four references to Christ, the Lord, who is ultimately the One we work for (6:5-8)
- *Christian employers should be marked by the same virtues as Christian employees should be (6:9)
- *Don't abuse your position as boss to intimidate people (6:9)
