Revelation 12

Three series of Judgment:

- The **7 seals** of the scroll are loosed marking the beginning of God's judgments (ch. 5-6)
 - These judgments look like indirect interventions of God affecting nature's elements.
- The **7 trumpets** sound God's call to war with the earth marking an increase of the severity of God's judgment (Ch. 8-9)
 - These judgments are seen as more direct divine wrath affecting mankind.
- The **7 bowls** are poured out marking the completion of God's wrath on mankind and the earth. (ch. 15-16).
 - These last judgments are the most severe.

Ch. 12:1- 15:4 form the third parenthesis in the chronological order of the book of Revelation.

- Ch. 12 Satan's purpose to destroy Israel.
- Ch. 13 Satan's puppets, the two beasts
- Ch. 14 Prelude to Satan's defeat and Christ's victory
- Ch. 15:1-4 Praise of the Lamb

History of Antisemitism

- Jews were forbidden to marry Christians in 399 AD, prohibited from holding gov't positions in 439, prevented from appearing as witnesses against Christians in court in 531.
- During the Crusades (1095) Jewish communities were targeted as well through looting, raping and massacre.
- In the 14th century the Jews were accused of poisoning wells and spreading the Bubonic Plague. In Germany and Austria around 100,000 Jews were burned alive.
- Starting in the 13th century many Jews were restricted to living in ghettos and required to wear a distinctive symbol like a badge or pointed hat.
- Jews were not allowed to own land, which led to many of them becoming moneylenders, since this was one of the few things they could do.
- The Jews were expelled from England in 1290, France in 1394 and Spain in 1492.
- Martin Luther became very anti-semitic and wrote against the Jews (1543).
- The Russian Czars in the last 1800s and early 1900s blamed the Jews for the country's problems and killed many of them.
- Antisemitism was strong during the beginning of the 20th century culminating in the Holocaust which killed 6 million Jews.

Timeline of Satan's career and downfall

- Satan was created as a beautiful angel and was called Lucifer, meaning day star. (Isa. 14:12-15 and Ezek. 28:12-17).
- He was lifted up in pride and wanted to seize authority from God (Isa.14 and Ezek. 28).
- He was cast out from his elevated place.
- He appeared to Eve through a medium, the serpent, and tempted both Adam and Eve to sin. (Gen. 3).
- Since the fall he goes about deceiving the nations (Rev. 12:9; 20:3), seeks to devour people spiritually (1 Pet. 5:8) and is continually at war with God and the saints (Eph. 6:12; 2 Cor 10:3-6).
- His domain is the "heavenlies", the unseen realm of angels (Eph. 6:12; 2 Cor. 11:14).
- Through the work of Christ on the cross and His resurrection the power of Satan has been broken (John 12:31; Matt. 12:29; Hebrews 2:14), but for now he is still very active till the return of Christ.
- During the middle of the 7-year-long Tribulation he shall be cast to the earth (Rev. 12:9).
- At the return of Christ after the 7 years Satan shall be bound for 1000 years (Rev. 20:1-3).
- After that he will be released for a short time and will deceive the nations to fight against God.
- Satan will then be cast into the lake of fire.

Three main entities are portrayed as "women" in Revelation:

- Israel (ch. 12)
- The Harlot, that is false christendom of the end times (ch. 17)
- The Church, the bride of the Lamb (ch. 19)

Jacob's trouble (Jeremiah 30:7)

- 3 1/2 years, the last part of the 70th week of Daniel 9:27
- 42 months (Rev. 11:2; 13:5)
- A time, times and half a time (Rev. 12:14; Dan. 7:25; 12:7)
- 1260 days (Rev. 11:3, 13; 12:6)
 - * The Jewish lunar calendar year consists of 360 days, so 360 x 3 1/2 =1260
