

Message on this line of the Charlottetown Bible Chapel's Statement of Faith:

“We believe in the absolute deity and full humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

The Lord Jesus is both God and man, one Person with two distinct but inseparable natures. Theologians call this the hypostatic union.

Matthew 16:13-16; 22:41-46 — —> What do you think of Christ?

Old Testament passages alluding to the Messiah's Deity:

Ps. 110:1; Micah 5:2; Isaiah 9:6; Zachariah 12:10

The glory of the Lord Jesus as God the Son is seen in attributes He has, which are Divine:

- * Creator (John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:15-17; Hebrews 1:1-2)
- * King (Hebrews 1:8; 1 Timothy 6:15; Zachariah 14:3-4a, 5b, 9, 16-17)
- * Saviour (Titus 2:13; 3:4-7; Isaiah 43:11; 45:21)
- * Shepherd (John 10:11, 28-30; Acts 20:28; Psalm 23:1; Isaiah 40:10-11; Zechariah 13:7)

The Lord Jesus is Son of God:

- From all eternity (John 1:1-2, 18; 1 John 5:20). He existed before He came.
- In His incarnation (Luke 1:35). Conceived of the Holy Spirit.
- In His resurrection (Romans 1:4). His resurrection proved His Deity.

The Lord Jesus as man linked with being:

- * Servant (Luke 2:49-52; Philippians 2:5-11) Submission
- * Mediator (1 Timothy 2:5)
- * High Priest (Hebrews 2:14-18)
- * Leader (Hebrews 2:10; 12:2)
