1 Timothy 6:3-21

Main subject of 1 Timothy:

Maintaining sound doctrine and proper conduct in the assembly, the House of God.

Timothy had to deal with three wrong influences threatening the assembly:

Ch. 1 - Judaism —> misuse of the Law and legalism.

It causes straying from the faith and turning to idle talk (1:6-7).

Ch. 4 - Asceticism —> disregard for the physical which God created.

It causes departure from the faith and giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons (4:1-2).

Ch. 6 - Materialism —> overemphasis of the physical and neglect of the God who gives life to all things (6:13).

It causes straying from the faith in their greediness, and piercing themselves through with many sorrows (6:10).

Materialism is the Western world's religion today. It's seen in:

- The over-estimation of "science",
- Extreme focus on physical safety and health.
- Environmentalism movement,
- Secularism,
- Evolutionary teaching for the origin of life,
- Politics being almost exclusively about economics.
- Excessive government and personal debt,

What the Bible say about riches:

"Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." (Luke 12:15).

"If riches increase, do not set your heart on them." (Psalm 62:10).

"Remove falsehood and lies far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches— Feed me with the food allotted to me; Lest I be full and deny You, And say, "Who is the LORD?" Or lest I be poor and steal, And profane the name of my God." (Proverbs 30:8-9).

The Book of Proverbs warns about wrong attitudes concerning money and work:

- -Laziness and leeching of others (10:4-5; 18:9; 19:15; 20:4; 24:30-34).
- -Crippling debt and discontentment (15:16, 27; 22:7)
- -Trusting in riches (11:28).
- -Greed and life's focus to be rich (13:14; 23:4-5; 28:8-9; 30:8-9).
- -Stinginess towards others (19:17).
- -Respecting people for their money rather than their character (19:6).

Imperatives for the man and woman of God:

FLEE the love of money and greediness (vs.11).

FOLLOW (or pursue) righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness (vs.11).

FIGHT the good fight of faith (vs. 12).

FASTEN (or lay hold on, seize) to eternal life (vs.12).

FEND (or guard) what was committed to your trust (vs. 20).

We can live the Christian life if we keep our eyes on God and His Son:

- God who gives life to all things (God is the **Source** of all life & blessing), vs. 13.
- Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession (Christ our **Example**) vs. 13.
- Our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing (Christ our **Hope**), vs. 14.
- God, the only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of Lords (He is my **All in all**), vs. 15-16.
