

Rule for Thousand Years

Revelation 20:1-3, 4

The Thousand Years

"Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to othe bottomless pit and a great chain. And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, and threw him into othe pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while...and they lived and reigned with Christ for one thousand years."



Meaning of the Word: Millennium

Latin Background

The term Millennium is taken from two Latin words "mille" which means thousand, and "annum" which mean years. When the two Latin words are combined that word simply means one thousand years.

What Is the: Millennium

This will be a period of time in which Jesus Christ will reign on the earth for 1,000 years in fulfillment of many prophecies. During this rule of Christ, Satan will be bound and sealed in a bottomless pit, so he will have no influence to deceive mankind.

Robert Thomas - Revelation (Chicago, Moody, 1995) p. 408 "No (time period) number in Revelation is verifiably a symbolic number"

Revelation 11:11 "And after *three and a half days* the spirit of life from God entered into them."

Revelation 11:3 "And they shall tread under foot forty two months" (3 1/2 years)

"Teleo" End Point of the Millennium Should be Taken as Literal





Four Reasons There Must Be a Millennium

Four Reasons

- 1. To Reward the Believers People of God
- **2 Timothy 2:12** "If we suffer with Him, we shall also reign with him" **Revelation 5:10** "And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth."
- 2. To Fulfill Old Testament and New Testament Prophecy
- 3. "Thy Kingdom Come Thy Will be Done on Earth As it is in Heaven" Matt 6:10
- 4. To Show the Depravity of Man (in a perfect environment) and the necessity of Christ's death

When Will the Millennium Begin?

Beginning of Kingdom

- 1. Second Coming of Christ
- 2. Defeat of the AntiChrist and False Prophet
- 3. Binding of Satan
- 4. Raising of the Tribulation Saints

What Needs to Happen First

Before the Millennium Begans there must be a number of Future Events found in Revelation 19-20

Resurrected Tribulation Saints - Rev. 20:4

"I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. (Matt 8:11)

Resurrections in Revelation 20:4

Interpret the Text Consistently

Amillennialists argue that the resurrection in Revelation 20:4 called the "first resurrection" is a spiritual resurrection that takes place throughout the present age. And the "rest of the dead" in verse 5 is a literal resurrection unto judgment. (Robert Gentry, William Cox)

Amillennialists teach the one is spiritual and there other is literal within the same context.

It this good Bible interpretation?

Three Reasons the Literal View

Revelation 20:4

- 1. The Word resurrection "Anastasia" is used 42 times in the New Testament. It is never used to mean spiritual "regeneration", but resurrection to physical life.
- 2. This interpretation forces us to interpret the word "lived" (Zoe ezesan the aorist form of the verb past tense) in verse 4 in a different manner than the same word in verse 5.
 - "Because both the first and second resurrections are described in identical terminology, ezesan, and because no qualifying adjectives or adverbs or anything else indicates that the two resurrection are different in kind, the attempt to make them different appears to be arbitrary" (Millard Erickson 1998, p. 99)
- 3. The grammar of the passage indicates that the entire group of saints begin its reign together and continue this reign for the entire 1,000 years.

Millennialist William Cox writes, "We believe entrance to the on-going millennium is gained solely through new birth, and that John refers to this as first resurrection." (Cox, 1966, p. 4)

The Curse of Sin Will Be Removed

Millennium

Isaiah 33:21 - "There the glorious Lord...for the Lord is our lawgiver, the Lord is our King."

Psalm 22:28 - "The kingdom is the Lord's and He is the *governor* of the nations."

v. 27 "All the ends of the world shall <u>remember and turn unto the Lord</u>; and all the kindreds (tribes) shall worship before thee."

Isaiah 24:23 - "Then the moon shall be confounded (light shall wane -NIV) and the sun ashamed (light of the sun fade - NIV) when the Lord of hosts shall reign in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously."

Isaiah 32:1 – "Behold the King shall rule in righteousness and his rulers with justice."

Christ's Reign Will Be Peaceful

Prince of Peace

Isaiah 2:4 - "They shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hook, nation shall not lift up sword again nation, and they will not learn war anymore.

v. 3 – "and he will teach us his ways, and we will walk in his ways...his Word shall go out of Zion.

Zechariah 9:10 - "Battle bow shall be cut off, he shall speak peace to the nations, his dominance shall be from sea to sea and ends of the earth.

Christ Will Reign over Israel

Over National, Restored, United Israel

Luke 1:32-33 Son of the highest shall be great, The Lord shall give to him the throne of his father David and he shall reign over the house of David forever and of his kingdom there shall be no end

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore.

Jerusalem will be the Capitol City of Israel and the World

Jerusalem Beautiful for Situation

Zechariah 14:9 - "The Lord shall be King over all the earth, and in that Day there shall be one Lord, his name one."

Psalm 48:1 Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, mount Zion on the sides of the north, the city of the great King." "Sides of the north" a place of great eminence – James Gunn -

Ezekiel 43:2,5,7 "And, behold, the glory of the God (Shekinah Glory) of Israel came from the way of the east; ... and the earth shined with his glory...His glory filled the temple...I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever."
